



BPIF Summary of Technical Notice published by the Cabinet Office

Accessing public sector contracts if there's no Brexit deal

Current situation

Under the UK's EU membership, all procurement opportunities that fall within the scope of the EU procurement directives are advertised on the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU) via Tenders Electronic Daily (TED).

Procurement opportunities for below threshold contracts not falling within the scope of the EU procurement directives are advertised on 'domestic' portals such as:

- Contracts Finder
- Public Contracts Scotland
- Sell2Wales
- eTendersNI

After March 2019 if there's no deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 with no deal in place regarding future arrangements on access to OJEU/TED, a replacement UK-specific e-notification service will be made available.

Impacts would include

- If you wish to access tenders from the UK public sector, you'll need to do so by accessing the new UK e-notification service. The UK e-notification service will be available from Exit Day.
- You will be able to continue to access the relevant domestic portal, such as Contracts Finder, MOD Defence Contracts Online, Public Contracts Scotland, Sell2Wales and eTendersNI.
- If you wish to access contract opportunities from the EU you will still be able to do so via OJEU/TED. [Additional information](#) on this has been [published by the EU](#).
